MCA Extends Validity of Name Reservation & Resubmission

MCA

- Extension granted by MCA for approved name reservations and e-form resubmissions up to 10 July 2026
- Extension granted as MCA Data Centre is disrupted due to fire incident.
- Stakeholders can raise ticket with the MCA Helpdesk within the prescribed timeline for extension

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MCA Relaxes Additional Fees for Form DPT-3

one-time relaxation allowing companies to file Form DPT-3 (Return of Deposits) for FY 2025-26 without payment of additional fees up to 31 July 2026.

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Supreme Court Recognises the Economic Value of Homemakers' Unpaid Work

Case Law

- Held in a road accident appeal case that household labour makes a significant contribution to the economy, despite not being reflected in GDP.
- Recognised new separate head of compensation "loss of domestic care"
- Emphasised that domestic work is a shared family responsibility, not solely a woman's duty.
- Reinforced the constitutional values of equality, dignity and social justice.
- Encouraged policymakers to consider unpaid care work in welfare and social security policies.
- Strengthened the movement towards gender equality and women's economic empowerment.

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Fewer Escape Routes for Personal Guarantors

Case Law

- Kolkata Bench of the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) admitted Indian Bank's application to initiate insolvency proceedings against a personal guarantor
- Held that creditors can independently invoke insolvency proceedings against personal guarantors for recovery of dues even if no proceedings initiated against the corporate debtor
- Several other earlier rulings conclude that settlement during liquidation process of a corporate debtor does not automatically discharge personal guarantors liability
